Happy Spring, Roy Community! We hope that you are out enjoying the sunshine and warm weather.

Prevention celebrated exciting victories during this past legislative session. The Utah State Legislature upheld a bill introduced in 2024 that banned the sale of flavored vapes and E-Cigarettes. The legislature — [S.B. 61, titled “Electronic Cigarette Amendments”](#) — passed in 2024 with the intention of [reducing youth consumption](#) of nicotine products. This victory would not have been possible without the diligent advocacy of community members, youth, and prevention specialists across the state. A special thanks to the sponsor of the 2024 flavor ban, Senator Plumb for fighting to protect our youth.”

This is an opportunity for community members to learn when and how to use a Naloxone Rescue Kit to rescue someone from an opioid overdose (End Users). *This class will not prepare you to teach others when to use naloxone.*

When you pre-register & attend the virtual training, you will be sent an iron-on patch, FREE injectable Naloxone Rescue Kits, & bumper stickers so people will know you care about saving lives around you.

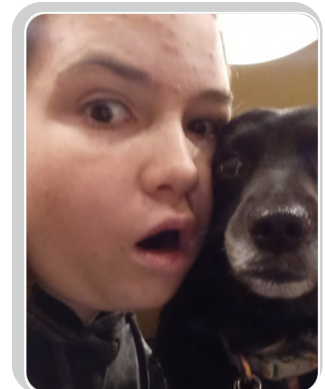

Raptors baseball games. Thank you Bridger for being part of the CTC Youth Council, we are lucky to have you!



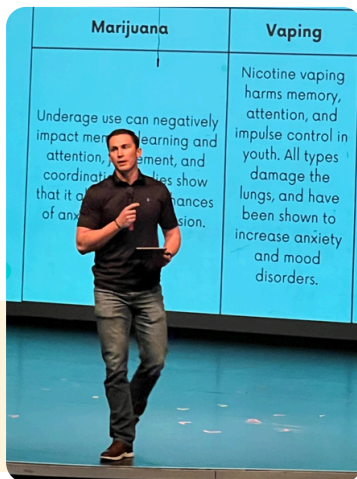

Thanks to everyone who came out for Parent Night!

The Roy CTC in collaboration with Roy High, Roy Jr. High, & Sandridge Jr. High, had Shardae Jones (Roy Communities That Care), SGT Connor Savage (Utah National Guard Counterdrug Program), and Heidi Dutson (Department of Health & Human Services) present to parents, students, and teachers on the importance of the SHARP survey. The SHARP survey is an anonymous survey given to elementary, Jr., and High School students to assess the health and well-being of youth in a community. With data collected from the SHARP survey, health and prevention specialists are able to assess specific areas in their community that are struggling and how best to aim their prevention efforts. This data makes our prevention efforts more effective, and is invaluable in determining how to help our communities be safe, happy, and healthy.
